The label helps manufacturers, suppliers, specifiers, and their clients quickly and easily find products that meet individual SKArating criteria. Whether it is construction products, finishes, building services products, or furniture and fittings, seeing the label instantly confirms a product's compliance with SKArating.

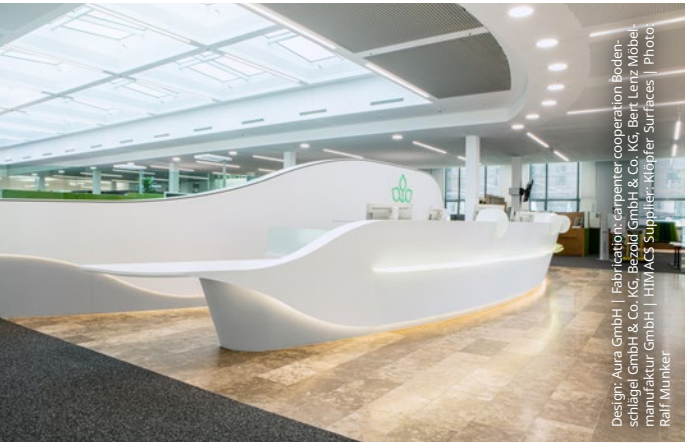

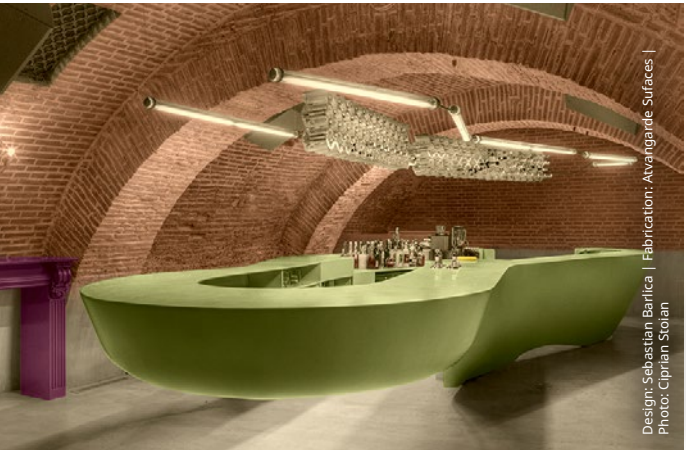

This project in Reading, designed by Stuart Melrose and Kev Munday, celebrates local creativity: The connection between the train station and the city centre is a huge collage of drawn objects and faces, all of which represent the area. If you look closely, you can see Kate Winslet, Ricky Gervais and Kate Middleton (now HRH The Princess of Wales), all of whom hail from the town. Behind the 54 sheets of highly translucent HIMACS Opal from the Lucent collection, sit over 100,000 individually controlled LEDs, transforming the wall into a colourful night-time attraction. Excellent strength, durability and easy maintenance make HIMACS the perfect choice for this high-traffic public installation.

Iconic and bionic



Creative architects require materials that enable them to bring their most imaginative ideas to life. At the A1 office building by renowned architect Eva Jiřičná, this wall sculpture, fondly named “Bionic Wall”, celebrates organic forms, achieved through a masterful blend of fabrication techniques. The milled surfaces are three-dimensionally thermoformed and assembled with barely visible seams. The slight distance from the wall allows for an atmospheric lighting concept. The material’s outstanding properties and ability to play with the light led to the choice of HIMACS, creating a dynamic blend of solidity and lightness.

The curved, monolithic reception desk, also fabricated from Alpine White, provides a striking formal contrast.

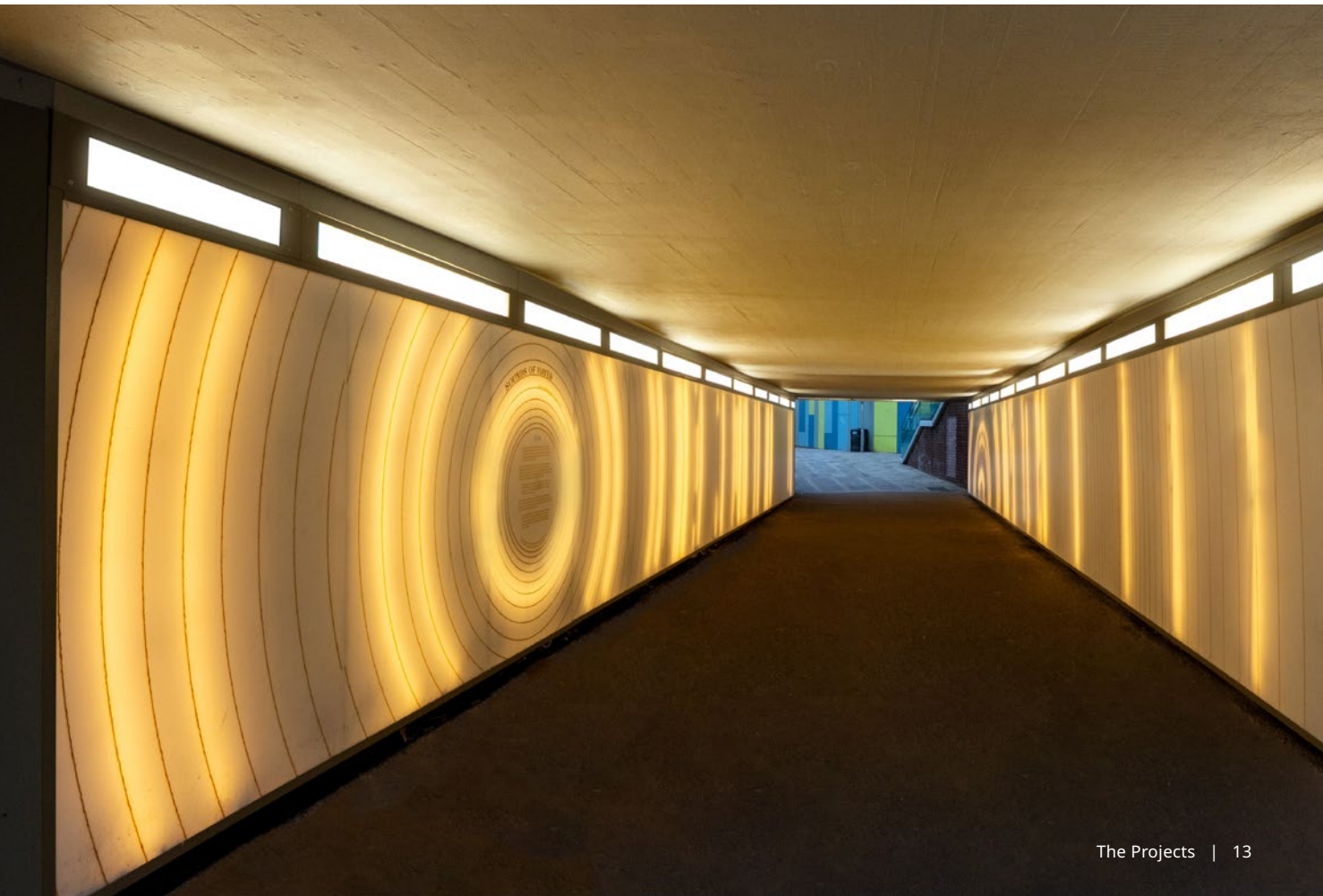

This artistic wall installation pays tribute to the look and feel of vinyl records produced for many years at the well-known EMI Pressing Plant in Hayes. The classic groove effect is achieved via concentric circles CNC-engraved into HIMACS. The Opal shade offers excellent translucency; moreover, the intensity of the LED lighting grows as day turns to night, ensuring not only a striking aesthetic but enhanced safety for pedestrians using the tunnel.

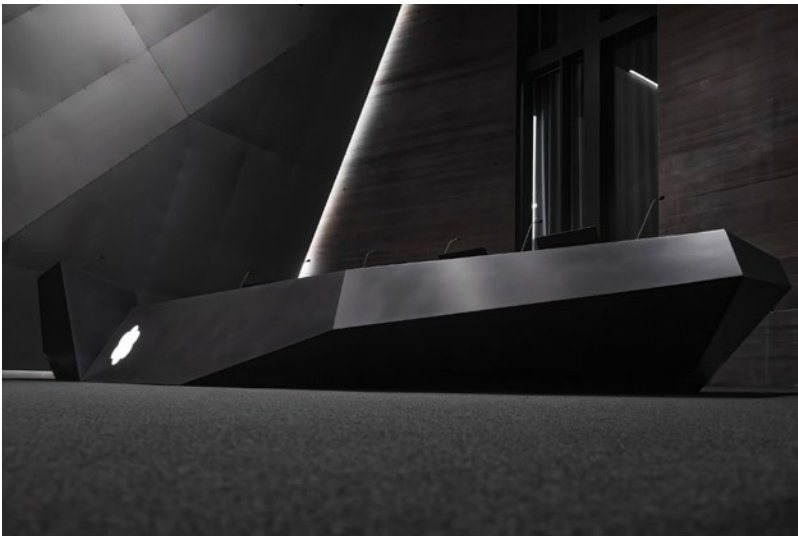

The striking workbench in the large auditorium, made from HIMACS in the advanced formulation colour Intense Ultra Dark Grey, is a monolithic piece that appears cast from a single mould. Aesthetic and functional highlights in HIMACS, from a geometric planter in the CEO's office, to the seamlessly angular conference room desking, appear throughout, including the staff kitchen and washroom areas. The material's hygienic properties and excellent resistance to intensive daily use add considerable value to the project.

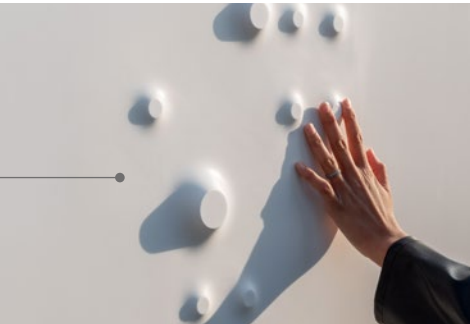


HI-mazing Design
